Location

The Department's three units are located in two different locations in Östermalm close to downtown Stockholm and 15 min from the Frescati main campus.

Courses for Exchange Students

30 ECTS is full-time studies and 15 ECTS should be taken from the Department of Media Studies. 15 ECTS can be chosen from any department offering courses in English to non-program students. Access to courses is contingent on the study background of the individual student.

Credit Transfer

Complete transcripts will be sent 4 weeks after the official last day of each semester in sealed, signed, and stamped envelopes.

Swedish for International Students

International students can take Swedish courses alongside their main studies during afternoon and evening times.

Best time to come

Graduate and last year undergraduate students of Media, Journalism, Cinema and Fashion Studies are welcome during both spring and fall semesters. First and second year undergraduate students of Cinema Studies can only be accomodated during spring semesters.



Orientation and Arrival

Orientation Week helps new students to settle into university life at Stockholm University. Arrival and free shuttle bus service to the university is available at Arlanda International Airport the days before the semester begins.

Housing

Student housing rent ranges from 15500SEK (dorm room/ shared apartment) to 43500SEK (private apartment) per semester. *The Department guarantees housing for overseas exchange students if housing applications are submitted on time.* Housing areas are found within 20mins of the campus.

Teaching staff can be accommodated at the University Guest Quarters in Bergshamra at a reduced cost (600SEK/night). For longer stays >1 month or more, apartments may be arranged.

Visa

Non-EU/EEA students staying for 3 months or more require a student visa. The application deadline is June 1 for fall semesters and October 15 for spring semesters. Applications are made through the Swedish Migration Agency's website.

Insurance

All incoming exchange students, visiting staff, guest teachers and researchers are covered by general insurances that includes emergency health and dental care, medical evacuation, assault, liability, and some personal goods coverage.
